



CHANGE OF VESSEL'S NAME

Maritime Authority of the Cayman Islands (Head Office)

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The following documentation should be submitted to change the vessel's name:

- Form CISR 854 – Vessel Name Proposal and Reservation.
- Form CISR 857 – Application for Miscellaneous Services.
- Form Request for Services (RFS) for re-issuing Insurance Certificates:
 - Vessel >300GT need new:
 - Certificate for Wreck Removal Insurance.
 - Vessels >1000GT need new:
 - Certificate for Wreck Removal Insurance; and
 - Certificate for Bunker Oil Pollution Insurance.
 - Tankers need new:
 - Certificate for Wreck Removal Insurance;
 - Certificate for Bunker Oil Pollution Insurance; and
 - Certificate Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage (CLC).
- Blue Card from the Protection and Indemnity (P&I) Insurer Club for the re-issue of Certificate(s) of Insurance.
- Undertaking to return the Certificate of British Registry.
- Change Vessel's Name fee.
- Insurance Certificate(s) fee.
- Courier fee, where applicable.

Prior to Change of Vessel's Name, all outstanding fees must be settled.
